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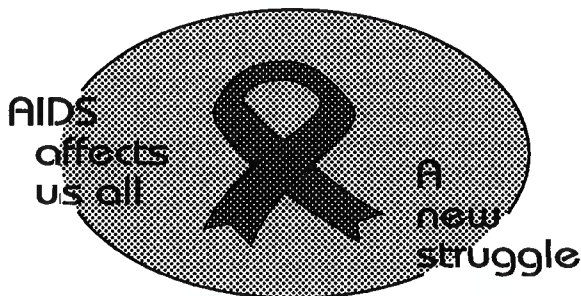

REGULATIONS IN TERMS OF THE EASTERN CAPE LIQUOR ACT, 2003 (ACT NO. 10 OF 2003)

I, Nonkqubela Pieters, Member of the Executive Council responsible for Economic Development, Environmental Affairs and Tourism in the Province of the Eastern Cape in concurrence with the Member of the Executive Council responsible for Finance in the Province, acting in terms of Section 69 of the Eastern Cape Liquor Act, 2003 (Act No. 10 of 2003) (hereinafter referred to as the Act), intend to amend the 2024 Regulations published in the Government Gazette No. 5319 under Notice 1260 of 2024, as set out in the schedule hereto.

Members of the public are invited to submit comments in writing, within 30 (thirty) calendar days from the date of publication of this Notice.

**SCHEDULE**

**Amendment of Regulation 16 of the 2024 Regulations**

1. Regulation 16 of the 2024 Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion after subregulation (6) of the following subregulation:

“(7) All prescribed fees in terms of these Regulations, if deemed necessary by the Board, shall with effect from 1 October each year, be adjusted annually in line with the average Consumer Price Index (CPI) as published by Statistics South Africa.”

**NOTICE OF ANNUAL FEES PAYABLE IN RESPECT OF A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION**

All registered persons in terms of the Eastern Cape Liquor Act, 2003 (Act No. 10 of 2003) and the Regulations thereto are hereby notified that annual licence fees are due, owing and payable in respect of all categories of licences. The renewal period commences on 1 October \_\_\_\_\_.

Payment Deadlines and Penalties:

The annual licence fees are payable from 1 October to 31 December each year.

- If annual licence fees are received from 1 January to 31 January: the fees payable will be increased by 50%.
- If the annual licence fees are received from 1 February and up until 30 June: the fees payable will be increased by 100%.

**No fees shall be accepted after 30 June and the licence will be cancelled without any further notice.**
